

Looking for something to do between sessions? Check out our travel recommendations while in Portland!

Portland

- Forest Park. Large urban forest with over 80 miles of trails.
- <u>Portland</u> Rose Garden, Portland Zoo, walk along the Willamette River, Japanese Garden, and Lan Su Chinese Garden.
- Local <u>Brewery tours</u> by foot, bike trolley, or bus.
- Rent an e-bike by the hour or day and explore Portland's various neighborhoods.

North Coast

- Cannon Beach, Seaside, and Astoria. Coastal towns along the Northern Oregon Coast and Lower Columbia River.
- Fort Stevens, Ecola State Park, and Nehalem Bay. Beaches and coastal hikes

Mid-Coast

- Pacific City, Lincoln City, and Newport. Coastal towns
- Oregon Coast Aquarium and Hatfield Marine Science Center in Newport.
- Yaquina Bay Lighthouse, <u>Devils Punchbowl</u> Natural Area, <u>Agate Beach</u>. Beaches and hikes.

Willamette Valley

- Over 900 wineries offers a variety of food and drink options.
- Silver Falls State Park. Waterfalls and hiking trails.

Mount Hood & Columbia River Gorge

• Historic **Timberline Lodge** on Mt. Hood

- Hiking throughout the Mt. Hood National Forest
- Drive along <u>Columbia River Highway</u> to visit multiple waterfalls and scenic outlooks along the Columbia River.
- Scenic hikes along the Columbia River Gorge
- Bonneville Dam tour and fish ladder viewing window.
